



Sykehusinnkjøp has used MEAT criteria in many pharmaceutical procurements for a long time

Especially for in-patient treatment



Many of these have environmental criteria

When used, they weighted 30%



The requirements have been developed in collaboration with our suppliers and they have been adjusted somewhat over time



The requirements have become more precise and we have added clear answer options

How to measure the effect

- All criteria must have a measurable effect
- What have you achieved so far?
- On which of these do you measure the effect?
- Or is it to incentivize the transition?



- ---- In Europe only trace levels can be attributed to waste from production.
- ---- A smaller fraction comes from the expired or unused medicines that are not correctly disposed of.
- --- The largest part is a result of normal patient and consumer use and excretion into wastewater treatment systems.

 The great persent up however region depending on the medicines observate interesting.







- A good question vs a bad question
- How do we get to the question?
- How to we get to the answers that you can choose from?
- How do both parties interpret these?
- Will it always be 100% correct?
- Process cooperation input dialogue
- Most important time when answering, give more rather than less input and answer all parts of the question. They often have 2-3 points that need answering



Easy to provide good answers





The supplier should have implemented an environmental management system in active substance production for the products offered, which takes care of risk assessments, environmental routines, environmental audits and sanctions in case of breach of agreement/environmental routine. To achieve the highest score, the environmental management system must be certified by a third party.

- -Implemented environmental management system for risk, routines, audits and sanctions that has been certified by a third party. (Specify which 3rd party certification has been used. Ex. ISO 14001).
- -Implemented environmental management system for risks, routines, audits and sanctions that have not been certified by a third party, for all offered products.
- -Partially implemented environmental management system (specify which parts/products have not been implemented, and which 3rd party certification has been used).
- -Does not have an agreement with third-party manufacturers on environmental management systems.

Evaluation

- Thorough evaluations of the offers
- Each supplier receives feedback on how they scored compared to other offers and is given the opportunity to further improve their work.



Supplier A's offer for Product A was overall ranked 2 out of 2. PRICE rank 2. Price offer between 20% and 50% more expensive than the most reasonable price offer.

QUALITY rank 2 (score 6)

EASE OF USE, PACKAGING AND PRODUCT RANGE rank 2. Criteria with lost points compared to other suppliers: On the criterion "Offered product should have inner packaging that best safeguards patient safety. Unit doses provide the best patient safety, ordinary blister packs provide less patient safety, boxes provide the least patient safety." Supplier Bs offer for Product B received highest score with justification: "The product on offer largely meets the requirement. Blisters have markings for each tablet. ." Supplier A was given a justification: "The offered product partially meets the requirement. Blisters without markings for each tablet. ."

SECURITY OF SUPPLY rank 2. Criteria with lost points compared to other suppliers: On the criterion "Offered product should have common Nordic packaging" Supplier B's offer for Product B received the highest score with the justification: "Offered product meets the requirement." Supplier A received a justification: "The offered product does not meet the requirement."

ENVIRONMENT rank 1 (score 5)

ENVIRONMENT ORGANIZATIONAL rank 1. Criteria with lost points relative to other suppliers: None.

ENVIRONMENT AT PRODUCT LEVEL rank 1. Criteria with lost points relative to other suppliers: On the criterion "Offered product should be manufactured by a supplier that can demonstrate compliance with the AMRIA Antibiotic Manufacturing Standard or a similar manufacturing standard that combats antimicrobial resistance throughout the supply chain. To achieve the highest score this must be certified by a third party or the certification process must have started." Supplier B's offer for Product B received the highest score with the justification: "The supplier partially fulfills the requirement for the offered product. Indicates compliance with the AMRIA standard throughout the chain, but that this is not 3rd party certified." Supplier A received a justification: "Does not meet the requirement. Indicates that 3rd party certified standards are followed in parts of the chain, but does not indicate which standard or certification is used."

 - Existing and new standards





- Safety stock and early warnings
- Find foreign packages within your organization
 - Lead time: 4-6 weeks before H-prescriptions are active
- May be wise to be able to repackage due to restrictions in use if foreign packages in highrisk cases



Risk mitigation

- New reporting system instead of excel Early warning system
- Two variables:
 - Safety stock dedicated to hospitals (obligated)
 - 2. volume delivered (optional)
 - Why volume delivered?
 - Rationing and exports
 - Expected volume (Farmastat)
- The hospital and supplier both benefit greatly
